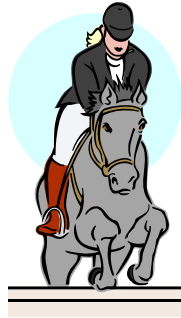

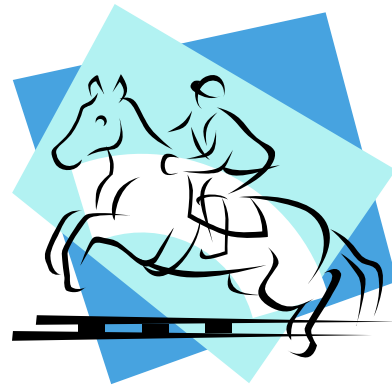

# Hanoverian

## Breed of the Month

The Hanoverian is the best known of the European Warmbloods, and has become very popular in the United States. The breed originated in northern Germany in the state of Lower Saxony, the former kingdom of Hannover. A flourishing horse-breeding industry has existed here for almost 300 years at Celle. Although the Hanoverian Studbook was officially begun in 1888, detailed pedigrees have been kept since the late 1700's. Originally, Thoroughbreds were crossed with Holsteiner mares to improve the quality of horses for cavalry and farming. In the past 70 years, the Hanoverian breeding program has adapted to the need for a more athletic riding horse, introducing other breeds as appropriate. The result is the modern Hanoverian horse. The Hanoverian has elastic gaits characterized by an elastic ground-covering walk, a floating trot, and a round, rhythmic canter. The Hanoverian stands at 15.3 to 16.2 hands. They are strong and athletic, and are quite even-tempered.



We want to introduce you to one of our newer members.... Kailyn Sissom. She's 12 years old going into 7th grade at Friends Christian Middle School. She leases a pony named Cammie (short for Campbell's Ms. Fury). Cammie is 23 years old, a registered P.O.A. (Pony of America), Appaloosa (white body, black legs and rust-brown spots all over her body) and 13.2 hands tall. Cammie is very friendly and a "prankster"; loves to eat. Kailyn's favorite thing to do with her pony is to ride bareback. Her favorite color is red and her favorite breed is the Norwegian Fjord. Her "dream" horse would be any kind of draft horse. 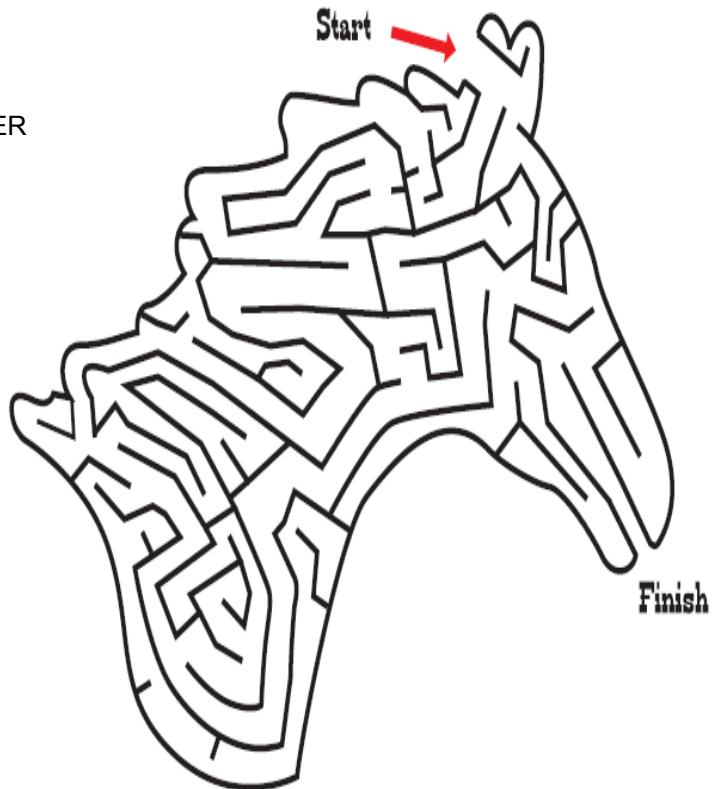
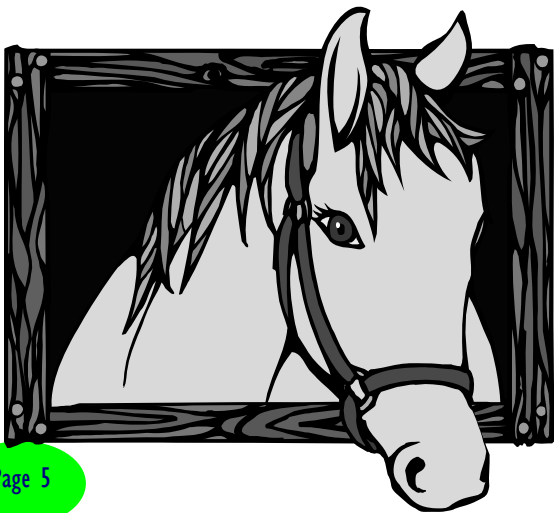


Force is a five year old Arabian gelding. He had a brief career as a race horse before becoming a pleasure riding horse. He has amazing bloodlines -- his sire is the famous Virgule Al Maury and his dam is the stakes placed mare More O Dora, by Samtyr. Force is the full brother to two time Darley Award winner More Adorable (Champion 3 and 4 year old filly). Since his retirement from racing, Force has been used in huntseat and western riding lessons with all levels of riders, including beginners. He is also being used in Pony Club. Force has recently been started over cross-rails and he is a willing jumper. He is a calm, sensible horse who tries hard to please. He has plenty of get up and go when asked, but is easy to slow down. He would make a great dressage or hunter show horse. He is very intelligent and learns quickly. Force is easy to speed up or slow down within gaits, and is very responsive to his rider's body position. He recently attended his first horse show and remained calm and behaved well. Force is a very flashy horse with great movement.
